# HISTORY TIME

The Riverland is steeped in history that extends beyond the river itself. At every corner along the road, every river township you enter, every trail you venture and every stream you encounter, there's a new discovery to be made and story to

Stories that date back thousands of years and remain precious today. From our First Nations people, and the geological wonders of an ancient land, to the colonial history of steamboats plowing the waters and wartime accounts, be inspired by the tales of the yesteryear.

#### **LOCKS AND WEIRS**

In the 1920s, a series of locks and weirs were installed along the River Murray, used to divert water to the emerging agriculture industry and to improve the navigation of boats along the river.

There are six locks in the Riverland between Blanchetown (Lock 1) and Murtho (Lock 6). You'll find interpretative information at Locks 1-5 along with the barge, Bunyip, located at Lock 5, which explains how the locks were built and how they are operated. Locks 2, 4 and 5 also have free BBQ and picnic areas and if you're lucky, you may even see a boat pass through the lock chamber.

#### **RIVER CROSSINGS**

#### **Ferries**

Ferries were used to cross the river as early as the late 1800s and were the arteries of life for the region.

Today the remaining ferries make part of the local transport network in the Riverland. These modern, cable ferries operate 24 hours and are free to use. Ferry crossings can be found at Lyrup, Waikerie, Cadell and Morgan with each vessel named after a native bird species.

# Paringa Bridge

At the time it was opened in 1927, the Paringa Bridge was one of the most significant early steel bridges in South Australia. Originally designed for road and rail traffic, the historic lift-span bridge and associated railway have played an important role in local communications, especially during times of

flood. The rail section of the

bridge has been converted into a pedestrian walkway, with the lift span still operated each day at 9.30am and 2.30pm when boats need to pass.

# **WAR TIME**

The Riverland has a rich, ingrained war history with significant links to local industries - still evident in many ways today.

The region played a significant role after both **World Wars** 

The region played a significant role after both World Wars. with soldier settlement schemes established to repatriate and compensate returning servicemen and their families. The schemes, which offered farming land to returned soldiers, were integral to the growth of many Riverland towns, stamping a long lasting legacy on local agriculture, innovation, culture and resilience.

Take a step back in time at Olivewood Historic Homestead, which was the Riverland home of Charles Chaffey, and today serves as a museum of local history including pioneers and the development of early irrigation systems.

With a focus on early irrigation, steam-powered engineering principles and the unique Humphrey pump in particular, the Cobdogla Irrigation and Steam Museum is a must visit for every history buff.

While at Waikerie, learn from storyboards depicting early irrigation at Federation Park, or see the decommissioned Worthington steam engine at Pioneer Park. Loxton has a similar series of storyboards through the median strip on East Terrace. Relics of historic irrigation are found scattered throughout the Riverland with decommissioned pumps on show in many Riverland towns.



#### COUNTERBALANCE AND AVRO ANSON

Corner of Bookpurnong Terrace & Mill

by local artist Tim Balderstone.

Commissioned to acknowledge Loxton's Centenary of Proclamation in 2007, each of the sculptures' 10 glass plates represent each decade.

The nearby replica Avro Anson aircraft display was crafted by local community members Josh and Abe McIntosh.

#### **EAST TERRACE**

The community's farming history has been reflected in various pieces of public art within the town centre, from rustic art scenes in alleyways, to large Loxton signs at the entry to East Terrace and at the town wharf.

### **LOXTON TOWN FOUNTAIN**

Loxton Library & Visitor Centre Six copper plaques feature in the fountain's design, hand crafted by local copper sculptor Vern Wilksch, and depict the heritage and history of Loxton. Erected in 1991 and funded by local resident's John and Ruth Moore.

# LOCAL PRODUCE ORANGE MERINGUE TARTS

# **INGREDIENTS**

#### FOR TART CRUST

2 1/2 cups white flour 150g butter 1/2 cup white sugar 1 cup ice cold water 1/2 teaspoon salt

#### FOR ORANGE CURD

2 eggs
6 egg yolks
1 cup white sugar
200g butter
4 tbsp corn starch
Zest of 2 oranges
Zest of 2 lemons
1 1/2 cups orange juice

1/2 cup lemon juice
1/2 teaspoon salt

2 drops red food colouring (optional)

#### FOR CANDIED ORANGE

1/2 orange 1/2 cup white sugar 1/2 cup water + extra for boiling

# FOR MERINGUE

3 egg whites
1/2 cup white sugar

**METHOD** 

### 1. Add flour, salt and sugar to a bowl

MAKING TART CRUST

- 2. Cut butter into cubes and add to bowl, lightly coating in the flour mix.
- 3. Using a fork, cut butter into small chunks and incorporate with the flour until a consistency similar to breadcrumbs is reached.
- Add water, one tablespoon at a time, and mix until dough just begins to form (it may take a little more, or less than a cup).
- 5. Turn dough out onto a floured surface and knead for 5-10 minutes until smooth.
- Wrap tightly in cling wrap and store in fridge until ready to use (or at least 30 minutes).

#### MAKING ORANGE CURD

- Fill a small saucepan with a few inches of water and heat on medium. Cut the butter into cubes.
- 2. In a large bowl combine eggs, yolks, sugar, salt and corn starch. Whisk to combine until sugar begins to dissolve and the mixture becomes light and fluffy.
- Add citrus zest, juice and food colouring, then mix to combine.
- 4. Place bowl on top of saucepan (although water in saucepan should not be touching the bottom of the bowl) and cook while stirring.
- 5. After around 10 minutes the foam on top will start to disappear and the mixture will start to thicken.
- 6. Remove from heat and add butter one cube at a time, stirring to make sure each cube is fully melted (the curd will continue to thicken as it cools).
- Store in a jar in the fridge (leftover curd will keep for a few weeks).

#### MAKING CANDIED ORANGE

- Bring a small saucepan of water to boil over high heat.
- 2. Slice orange and add to water. Boil for 15 minutes, drain, rinse with cold water and drain once more.
- 3. Add sugar and remaining water. Cook for 15-20 minutes on a medium heat until sugar has dissolved and the liquid thickens, but does not colour.
- 4. Remove from heat and let cool.

### MAKING THE MERINGUE

- Allow egg whites to come to room temperature (you can use the leftover whites from the curd). Add to a bowl with sugar.
- 2. Using a hand mixer, beat on high speed until stiff peaks form (approx. about 15 minutes).

#### **MAKING THE TARTS**

- Preheat oven to 200°C. Grease a muffin pan with butter, line with baking paper and grease the baking paper.
- 2. Remove dough from fridge and roll out to be about 1 to 2cm thick. Using a saucer or small bowl, cut circles from dough and place in the muffin pan.
- 3. Poke the bottom of each tart crust a couple of times with a fork, then bake in oven for 10-15 minutes until just beginning to colour.
- 4. Remove crusts from oven and let cool. Increase oven heat to 220°C.
- Fill each crust to the top with orange curd mix and then divide meringue mixture on top.
- 6. Return to oven and bake for 4 to 5 minutes until meringue becomes golden.
- 7. Top with candied orange and serve.

Most parts of this dessert – such as the dough and orange curd – can be prepared the day beforehand and then assembled before baking for an easy end to a party or family gathering. Also save the extra egg whites from the curd to use later in the meringue mix.

# GETTING HERE AND GETTING AROUND

Whether it's a weekend away from Adelaide or travellers venturing along the River Murray, most visitors to the Riverland arrive by car.

There is a public transport service operating between Adelaide and the region, as well as between major towns, but as there is so much to explore away from the townships - having your own vehicle is recommended. If you're here without one, ask a local Visitor Information Centre to help plan your days to suit local bus timetables, or put you in touch with car rental operators.

For those having a night out, there is a fleet of licensed taxis, which also have small buses and can be booked in advance. With watering holes in each Riverland town, there's no need to travel too far for a drink or two.

If you're lucky enough to be touring the region by boat rather than road, there are public moorings for houseboats and small vessels so you can re-stock on supplies, dine or shop.

#### **VISITOR INFORMATION CENTRES**

Riverland's five accredited Visitor Information Centres are located in most major towns within the region, and should be a first port of call for information and advice on navigating the local area. Look for the blue and yellow to find friendly local staff, with excellent knowledge of the local region who can tailor your time to suit your interests.
