Rivergum Christian College's Emma Katsaitis said the annual trail would be bigger for this year's event.

"We were really pleased last year with the enthusiasm from participating exhibitors and from the families and children that took part," Mrs Katsaitis said.

"This year more exhibitors have come on board, so the Safari is gaining momentum. Credit also goes to Emma Gwiazda, executive manager of the Field Days. She has been pivotal in driving the overall growth of the event and essential in helping us continue the Safari tradition.

"The Safari has always been about family and for some this is the only event of its kind they do each year so we want to make sure it's special. We also want to thank our sponsors for helping us ensure its success."

"This year we have increased the number of bags," she said.

Mrs Katsaitis said being part of the Safari also helps showcase local businesses to a wider section of the Riverland community.

"The Safari is always fun regardless of how you're involved; it's about seeing the excitement on children's faces," she said. "The bonus for businesses is that the Safari brings new visitors to their sites."

"If you can find The Murray Pioneer team, you know you've found the secret location."





Bentleys best to assist with new climate reporting

LEGISLATION relating to mandatory reporting requirements that relate to greenhouse emissions has just been approved by The Australian Treasury.

This means large entities will officially need to disclose environmental, social, and governance (ESG) and climate-related information as part of their general financial reporting, starting at 1 July 2025. Reporting compliance for medium and smaller businesses will follow.

Bentleys partner David Papa is one of only a few Australian Government Clean Energy Regulators in South Australia. David also chairs the Bentleys national ESG special interest group across Australia.

He says "the importance of carbon neutral verification is especially apparent in light of the ESG revolution."

"These new laws will require businesses to disclose and report on their carbon emissions. Implications go further than benefits to the environment and businesses choosing to do the right thing," Mr Papa said.

"Banks and insurers are increasingly wanting to see carbon neutrality as an indicator of business longevity and sustainability. The inheritance of carbon footprint via the supply-chain places pressure on who organisations choose to do business with as a result of new, wide-spread business expectations and requirements."

According to Bentleys partner, and carbon accounting expert, James Allen, "B2B organisations that are recognised as carbon neutral are increasingly recognised as preferred suppliers as larger companies are compelled to disclose their environmental impacts".

"In other words, if you're a business who wants to continue selling to large organisations and supermarkets, the time to measure and get practical advice on carbon accounting matters is now," Mr Allen said.

Mr Allen says "business who lag behind are likely to not have security of supply agreements, or they may face shorter-term agreements as premium pricing for carbon neutrality continues to allude most".

Currently, few advisors have the depth of knowledge in ESG and carbon accounting matters required to make informed decisions, however there is yet to be a 'standard' implemented that prevents unqualified professionals from claiming expertise in the field.


