A Riverland We story

Kiralee and Nick's love story is simple and sweet.

The two met at McDonalds Renmark through mutual friends, however Nick was too shy to say anything to his future wife, so Kiralee took matters into her own hands and messaged Nick on Facebook.

Twelve years later, the pair tied the knot at the Saints Constantine and Helen Greek Orthodox Church, Renmark in September 2022.

The couple, who now live in Adelaide, got engaged in 2018 when Nick proposed on the way home from Renmark one weekend.

"When returning from Adelaide on a Sunday, I always fall asleep in the car, so he was hoping I might be asleep in the car but he had to stop in Truro so I woke up," Kiralee said.

"Nick drove to the Novotel in the Barossa Valley and said to me 'I'm just taking a detour' and halfway there I started picking up on things and thought, 'Well he wouldn't be making a detour through the Barossa Valley to get to Adelaide'.

"Eventually he said we were going to spend the night there and I just thought we were doing something romantic because he's not really good at secrets like that, and then he proposed.

"It was a complete surprise, I thought I was going to know when he was going to propose or I was going to find the ring but he was really good with it."

The couple opted to marry in the Riverland, to allow Nick's grandmother to attend the wedding, and to celebrate in Nick's childhood church.

For the most part, wedding planning for Kiralee and Nick was smooth sailing, with the biggest challenge being the Covid-19 pandemic.

"We weren't in a rush to get married within the year, we wanted to be engaged for a little bit because we were also in the middle of building our house, so we just sort of waited and then last year we decided to start planning it and get married," she said.

A picture-perfect day was had, with Kiralee saying everything down to the weather was perfect.

Kiralee said she would definitely encourage anyone thinking of getting married in the Riverland to do so.


"I think it's so stress free," she said.







Brooke Durdin and Geordie Franks met through local sport and realised they were destined to spend forever together after four years of close friendship.

Together for three years before Geordie popped the question, Brooke was whisked away on a surprise weekend getaway in December 2021.

"The whole weekend I had no idea where we were going and I hate surprises," Brooke said.

"He had planned down to the minute of how he wanted to propose – he wanted it to be at sunset with a specific song playing."

Engaged for just 11 months, the couple began organising the big day straight away and married in November 2022.

Brooke said due to the short timeframe, the only difficulties the pair faced included organising suppliers and photographers.

"I'm a planner girl anyway, so I really enjoyed the whole process to be honest," she said.

"Because we'd talked about it before, we kind of had an idea in our heads of what we wanted the wedding to be like, so we were always on Pinterest and making mood boards."

The couple handmade a lot of their

wedding décor, including the bar, wine and cocktail station, timber picture board, an arch photo background and signage, and lawn games such as Connect Four, cornhole, 'Yardzee' and Jenga.

"It was nice that everything was made with love and our guests loved it," Brooke said

"We also hand-stamped our confetti out of gum leaves into love hearts – it was so time consuming but so beautiful."

As locals, a Riverland wedding was always going to happen.

"We wanted it to be by the river – why not showcase what we have to offer, especially for family members who don't live around here?" Brooke said.

"It was so nice to see the river while we were getting married."

Even the pair's dogs Maisy and Jäger were included on the day, with fresh flowers around their necks, courtesy of Renmark Flower House.

The thunderstorm on the Franks' wedding day added to the atmosphere and was taken advantage of for some spectacular photography.

"It rained all morning, and the girls and I had rehearsed how we would hold the umbrellas down the aisle, but to our surprise it was sunny and people actually got sunburned during the ceremony," Brooke said.

"On our way out to our photos you could see the lightning coming and we thought it was perfect timing. We went back, started our speeches and it just bucketed down with rain for hours, so everyone was stuck in the marquee but it was amazing."

Local businesses were a breeze to deal with, especially when it came to Sophie's hair and make-up.


"I had to go for trial runs and their communication was unbelievable – they could fit me in for any time that we were coming up from Adelaide."






